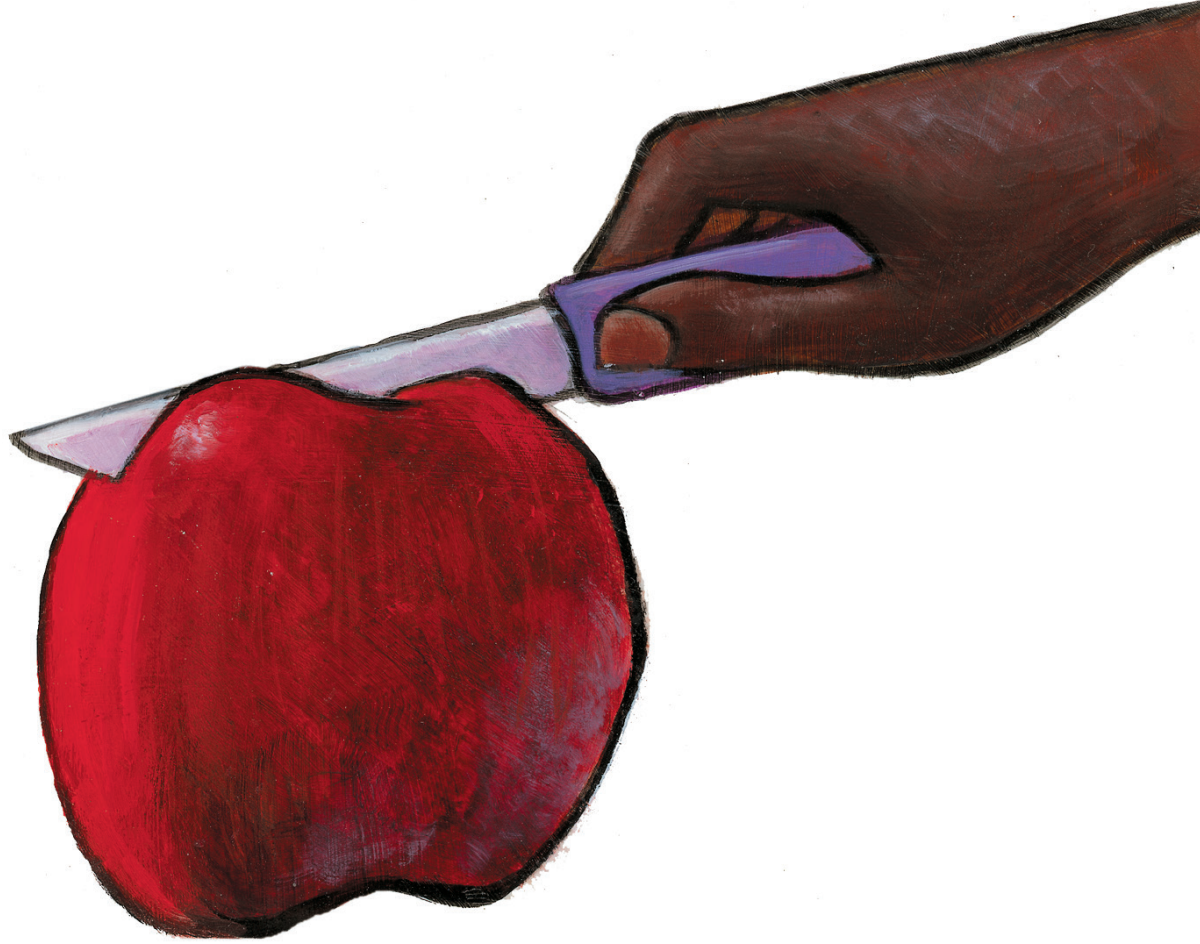


1 red apple in my hand,

3 friends are at my door.





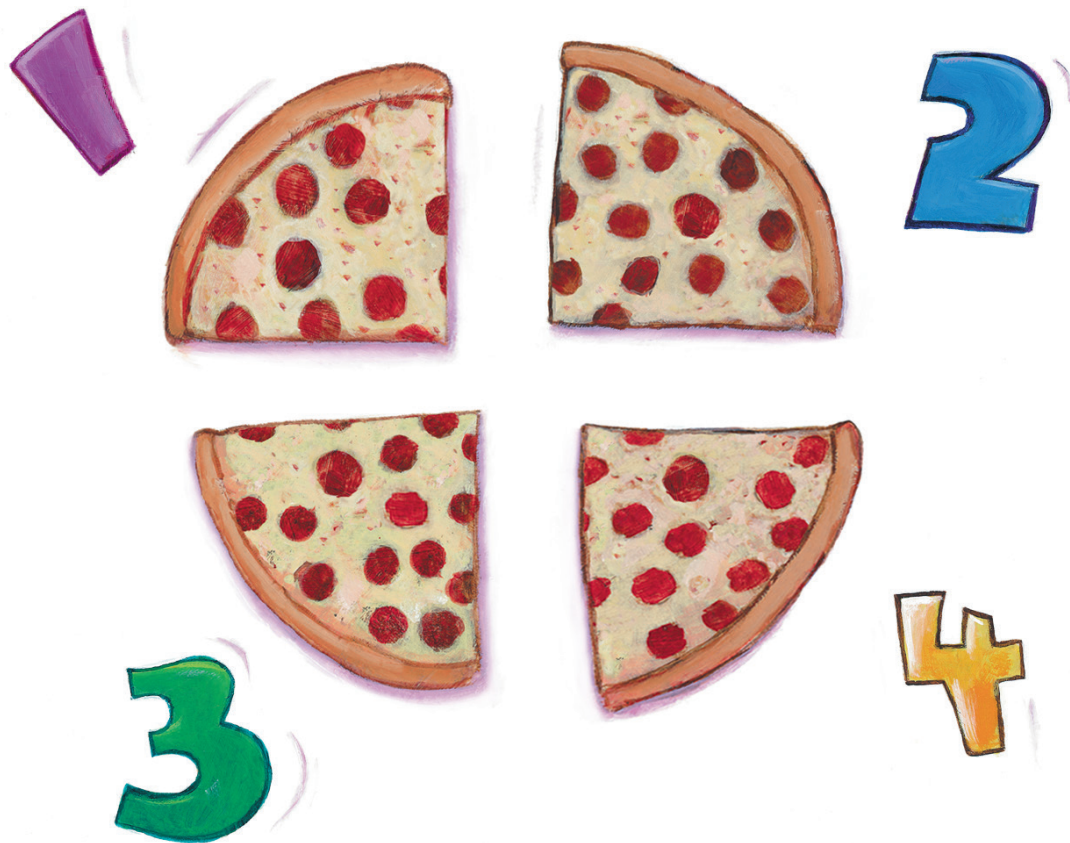
If Mom cuts it up 4 ways,
