




20 circus stars line up to start their show.




3 trapeze artists dazzle the crowd below.



20 - 3 = 17. Now 17 circus stars wait to take their turn on stage.




Then 4 growling performers enter by the cage.



17 - 4 = 13. Now 13 circus stars are left to wow the crowd.




6 pretty actors enter looking very proud.



13 - 6 = 7. Now 7 circus stars each practice their big start.




3 silly actors come out to do their part.
