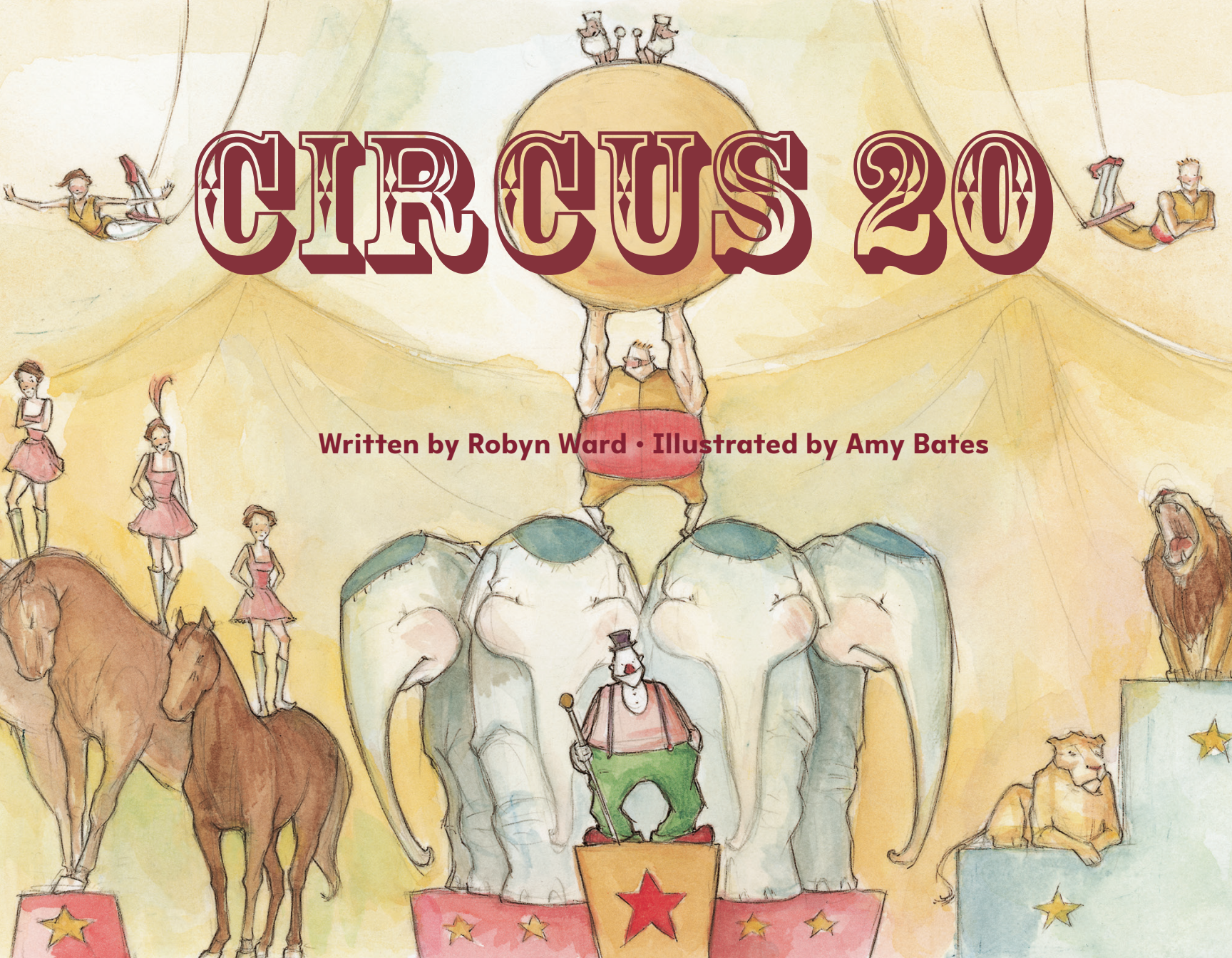


CIRCUS 20

$13 - 6 = 7$. Now 7 circus stars each practice their big start.



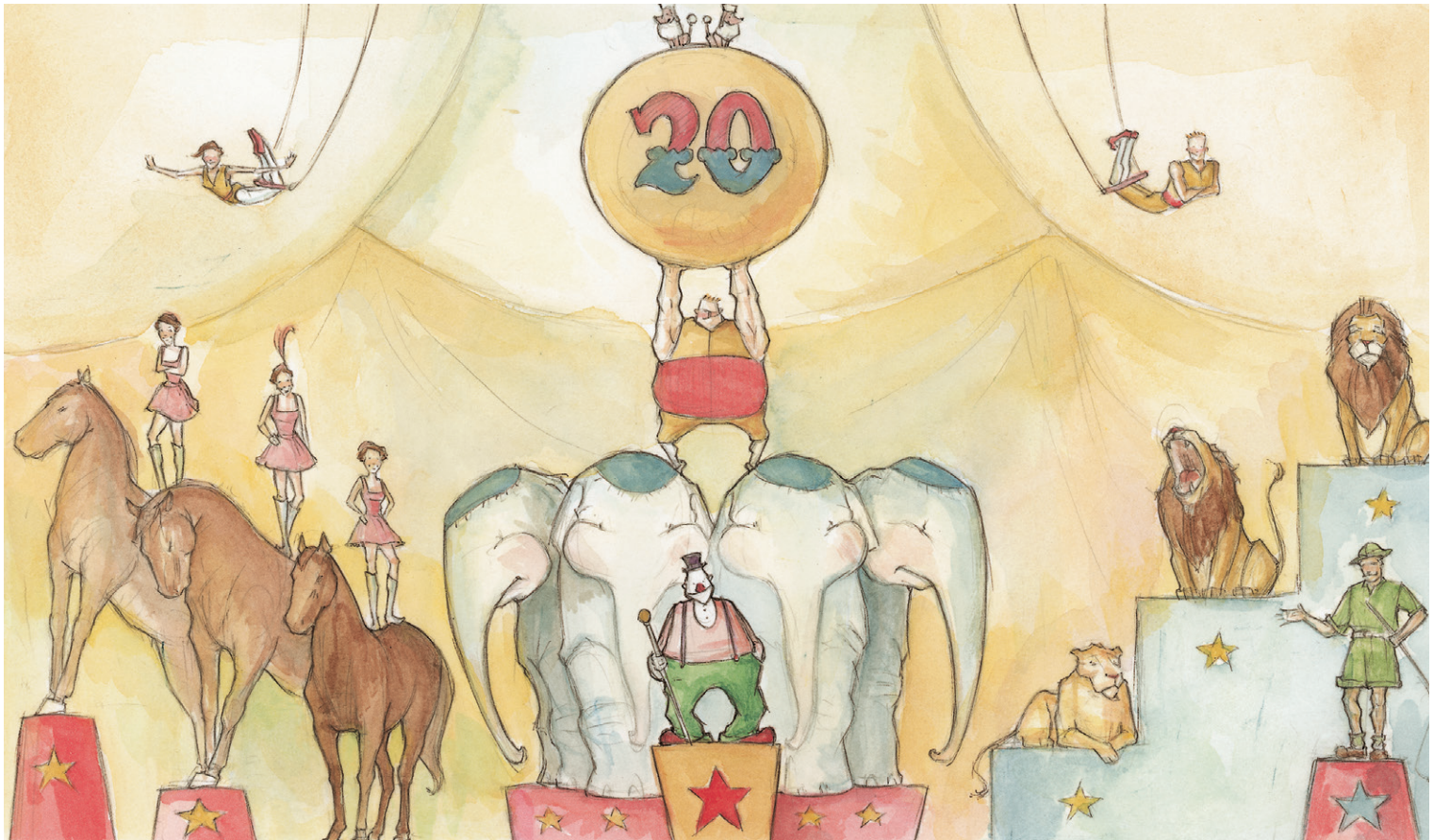
3 silly actors come out to do their part.
