Nicky is excited. He wants to give his mom a gift for Mother's Day. But what should he give her?

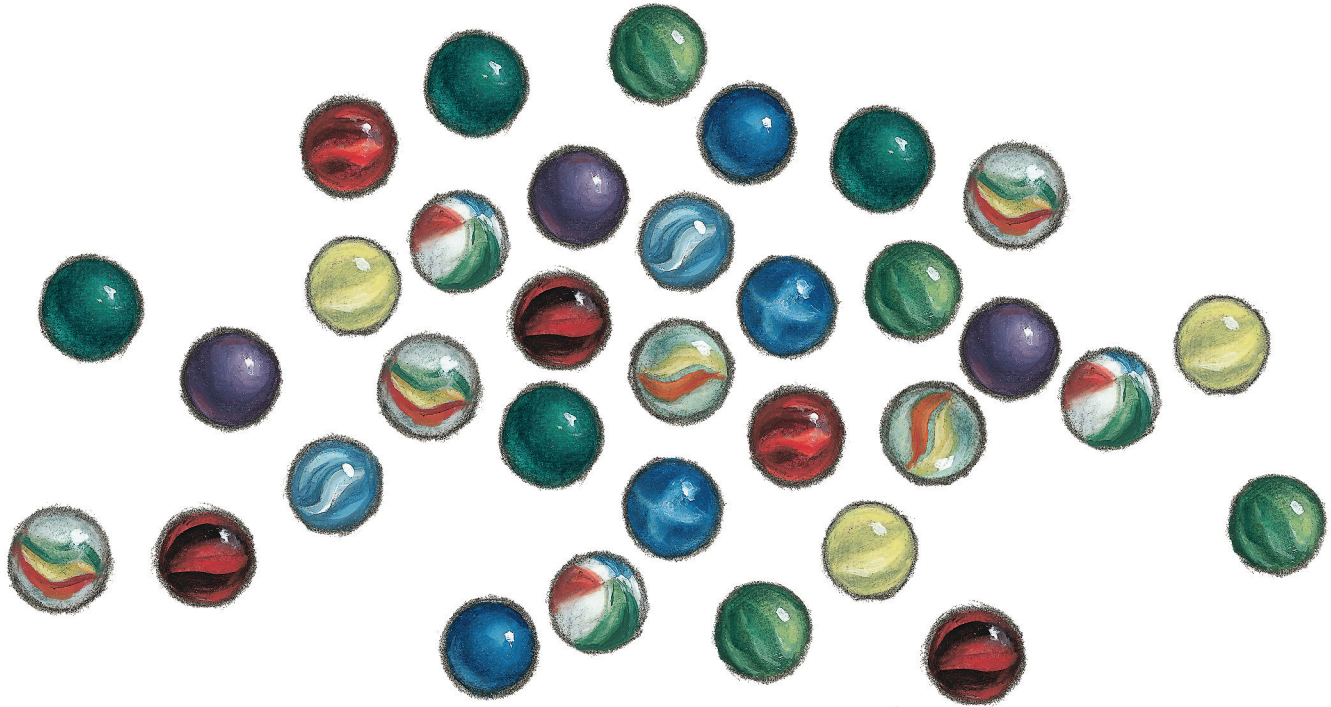


Nicky empties his piggy bank and finds

But why do moms need marbles anyway?

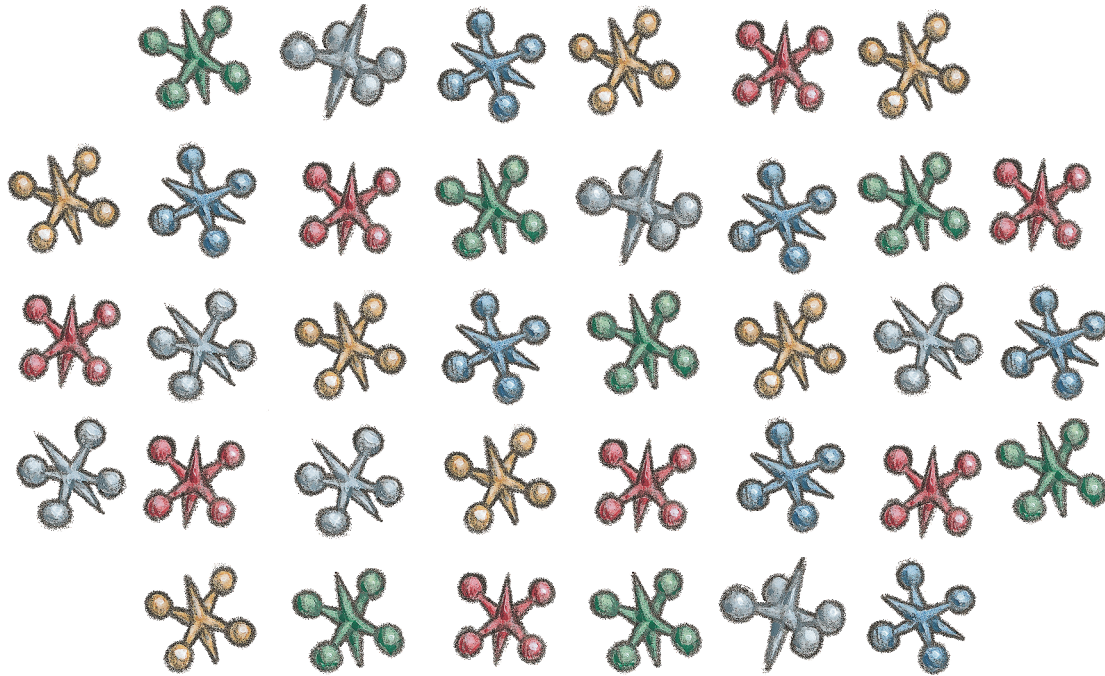


His mom likes popcorn! He counts 34 kernels from the bag. But 34 pieces of popcorn isn't very much.
