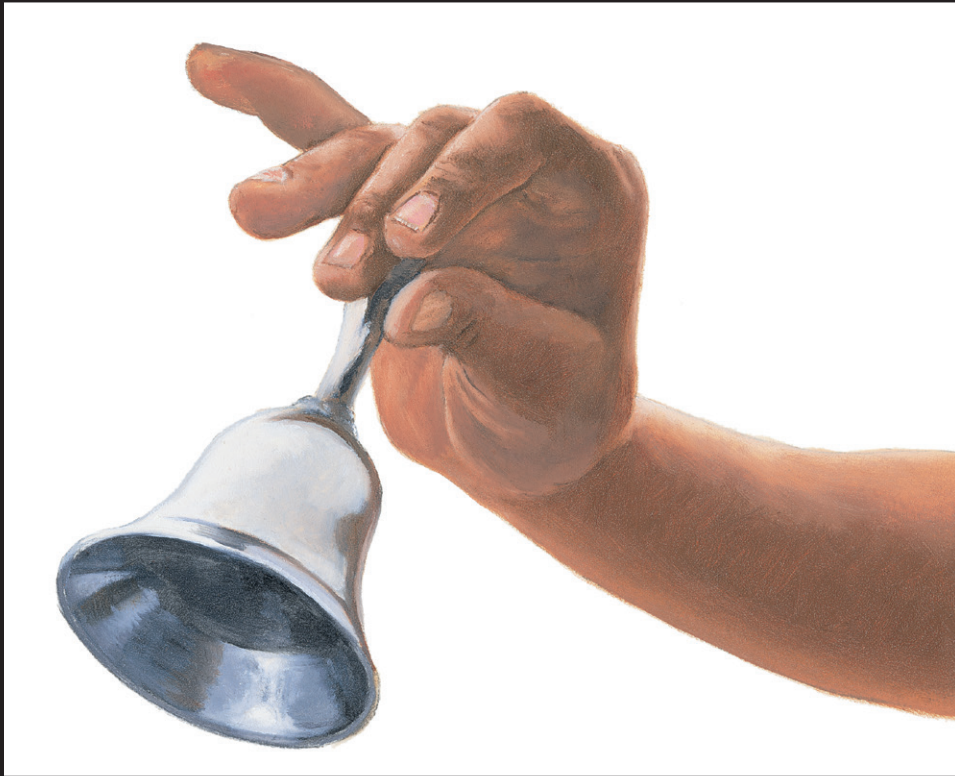
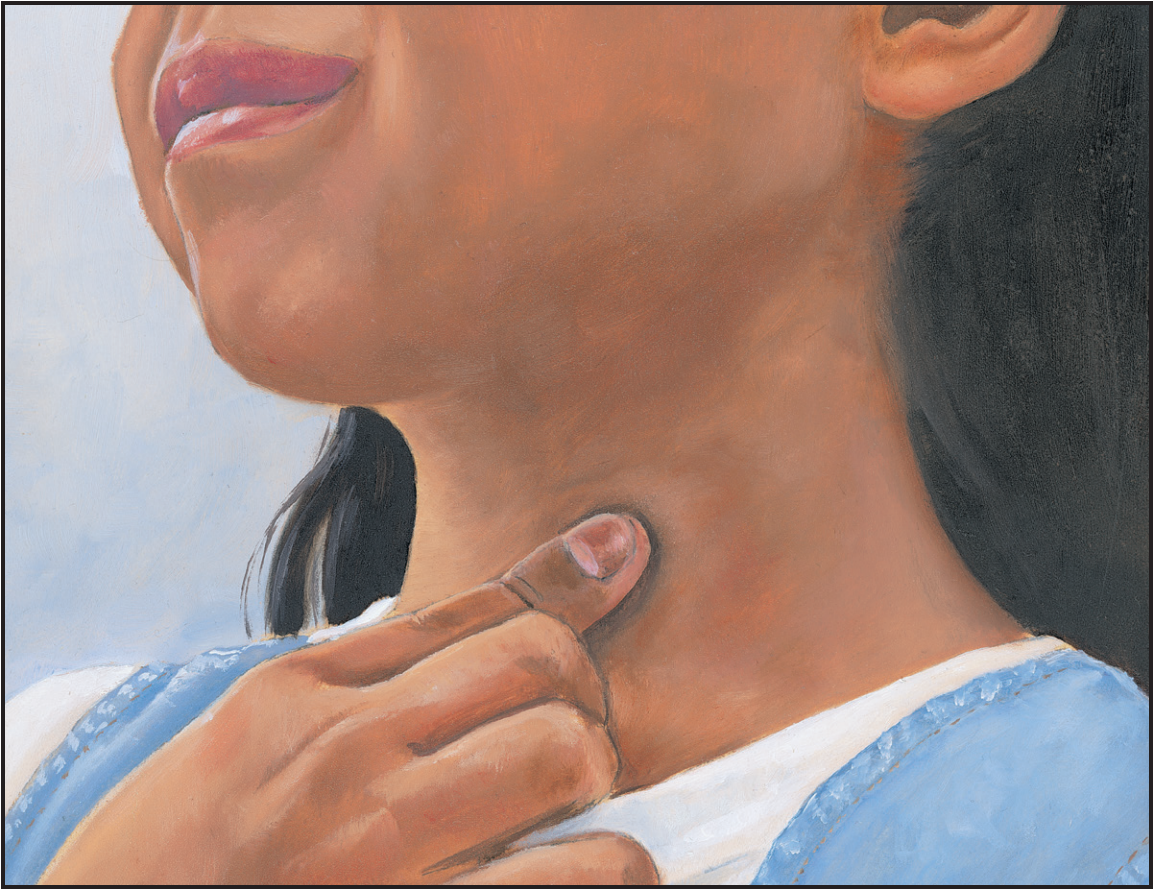


Sound

and listen to it ring.



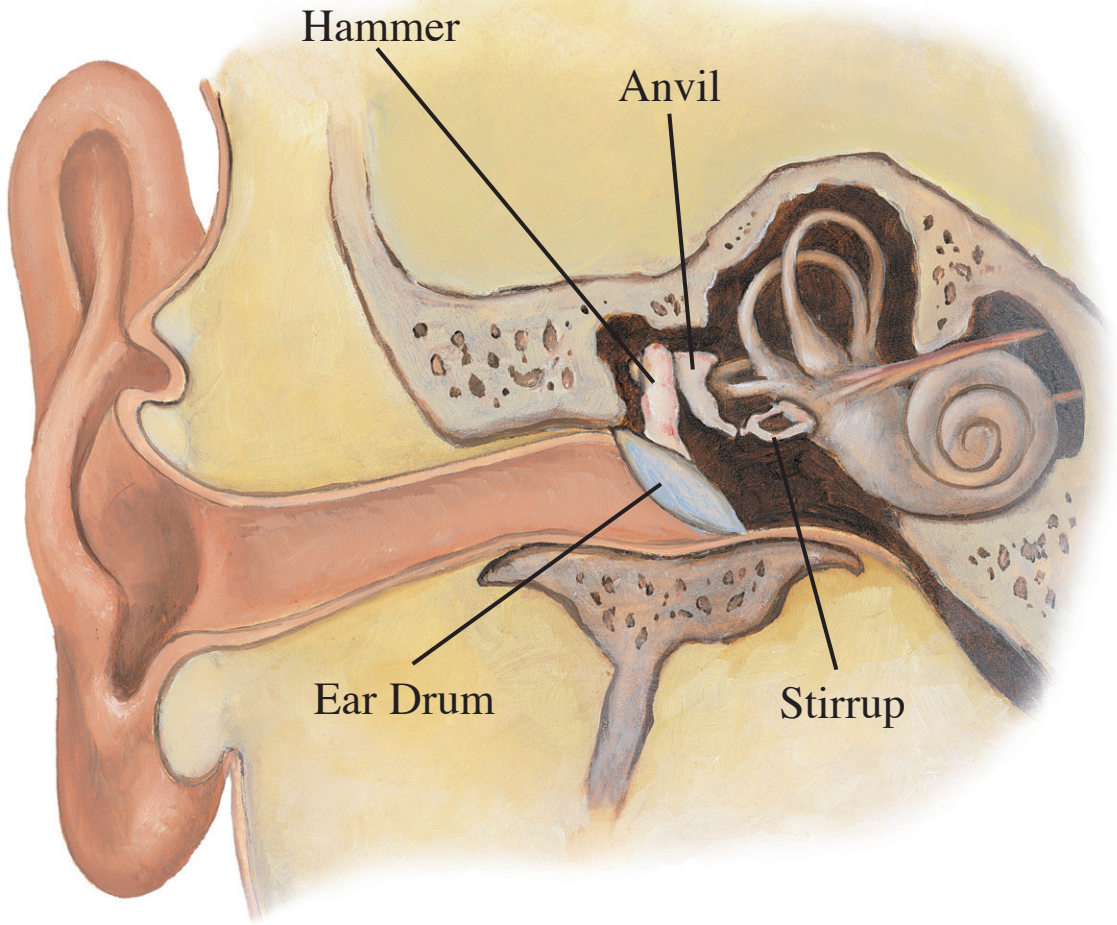
Sound is a vibration.
