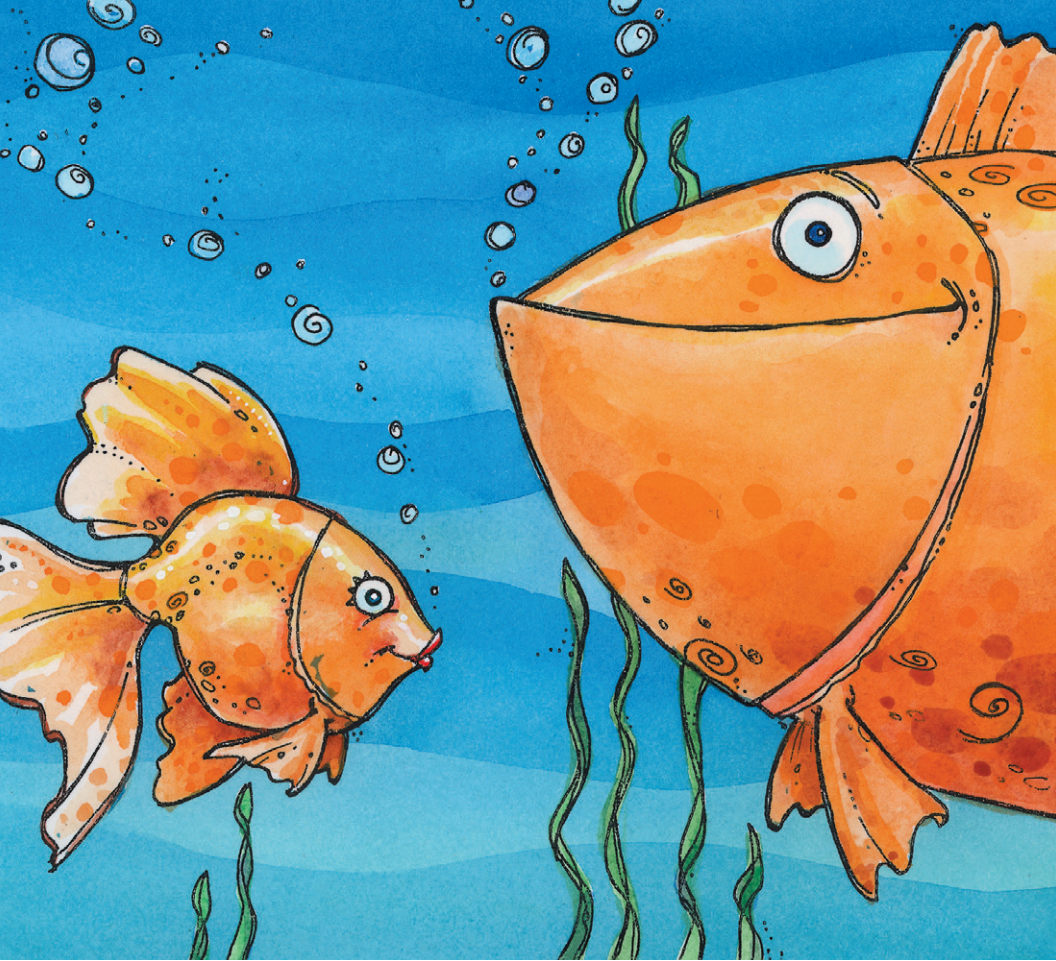

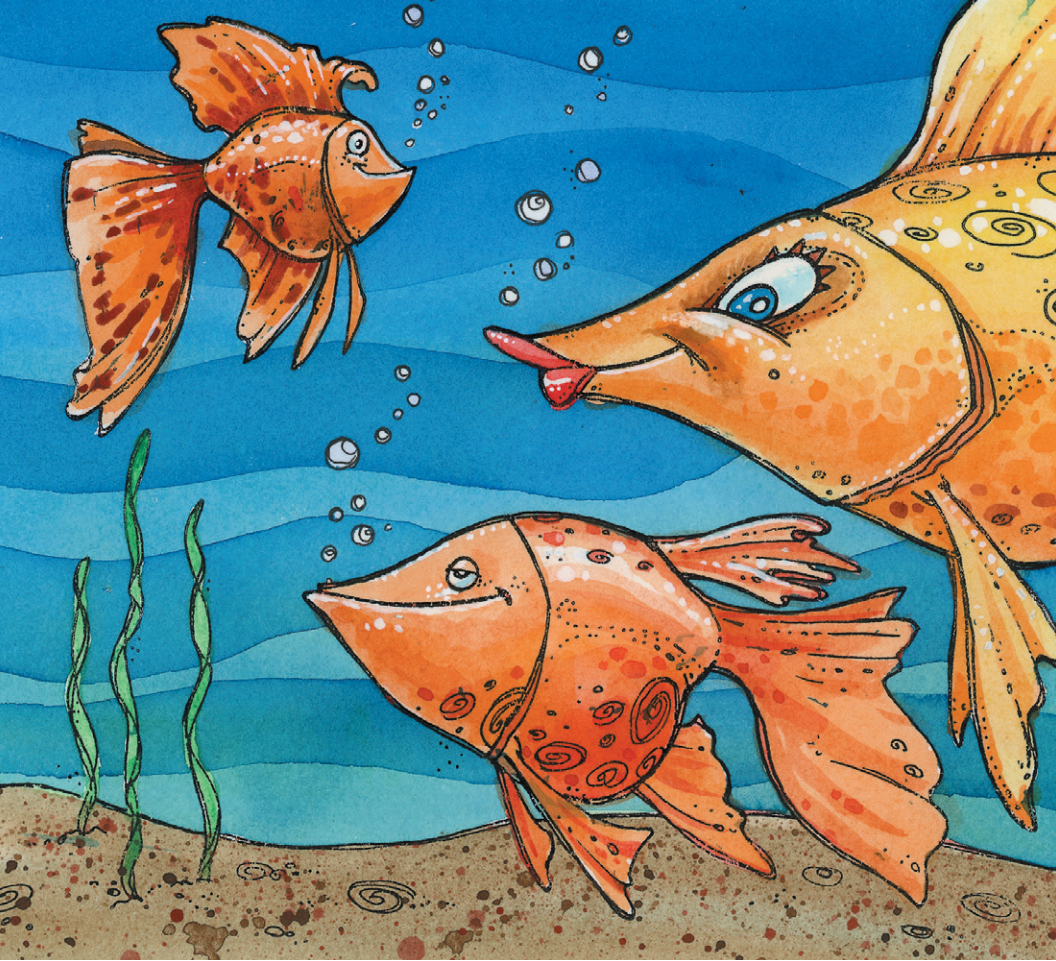
This book features the letter *Gg*. The rhyme helps children expand their vocabulary and learn about the sounds of language.

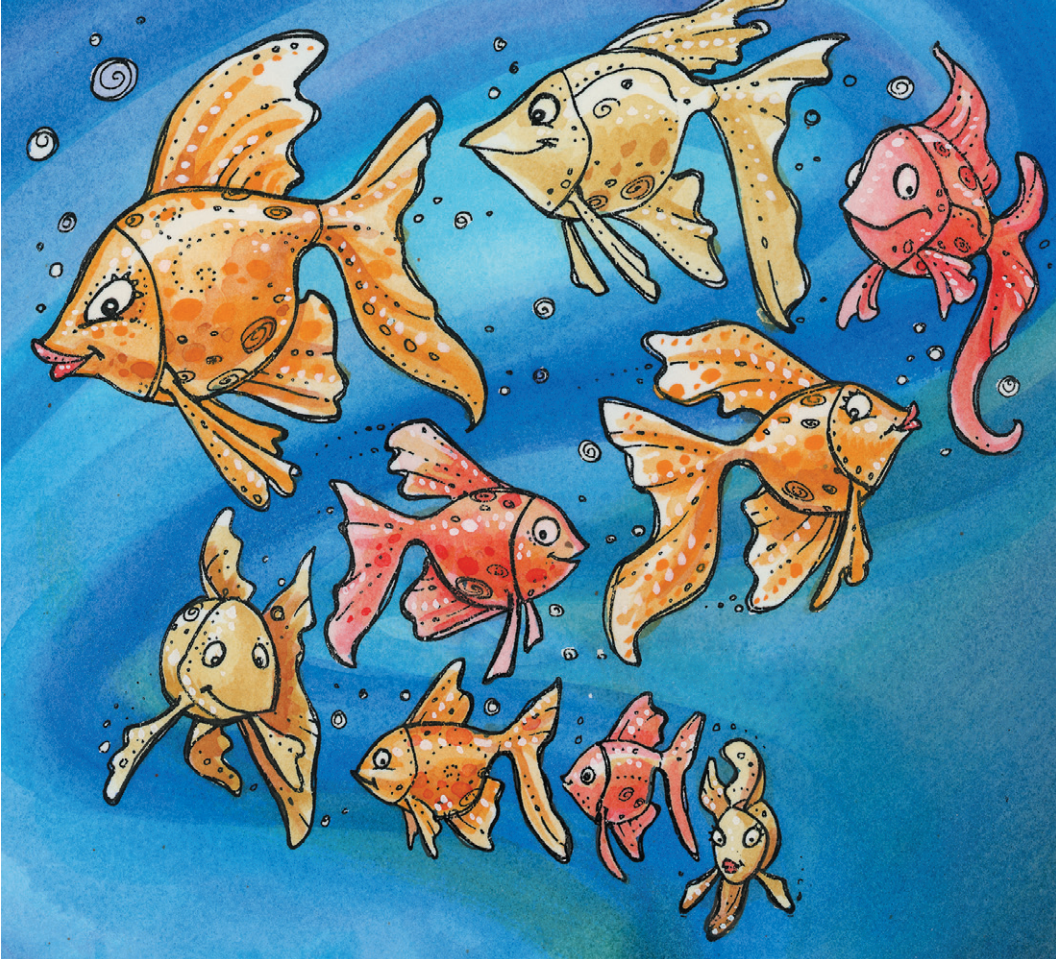

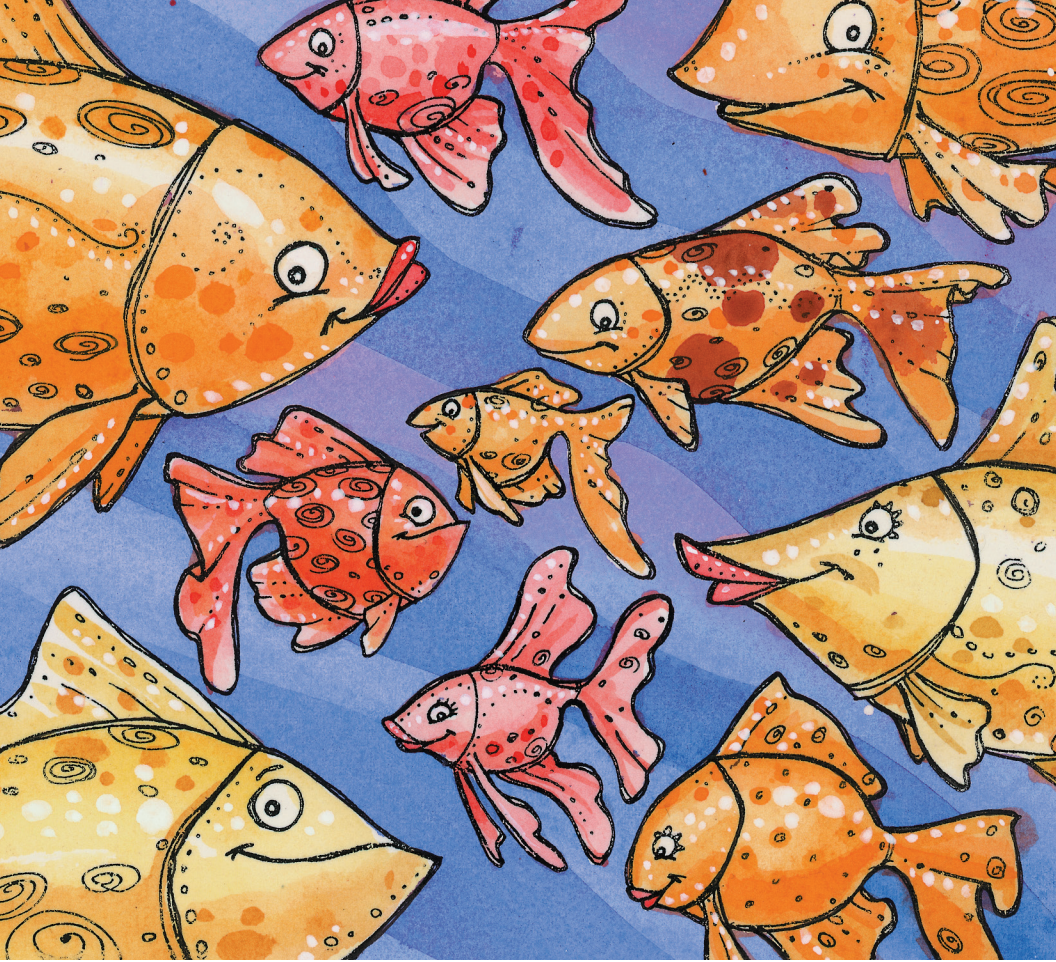
