Goldilocks and the Three Bears

Use these simple activities to have fun reading together!

Talk About Favorite Parts of the Story

Ask your child to find their favorite page in the story. Reread the page together and talk about why the page is their favorite. Then turn to your favorite page and talk about it. As your child is talking, encourage them to use the characters' names.

Take a Picture Walk

Do a picture walk with your child. Starting at the beginning of the story, turn to each picture. Ask your child what happened on the page, using the picture for clues. Remind your child to use the names of the characters. Also, help them use specific details like mentioning porridge as the name of the food.

Discuss Characters' Feelings

Talk to your child about Goldilocks' actions in the story. Discuss why she went in the home and whether that was a good choice. Then, talk about how the bears felt when they returned from their walk. Discuss what Goldilocks should do differently in the future if she sees a house in the woods.
